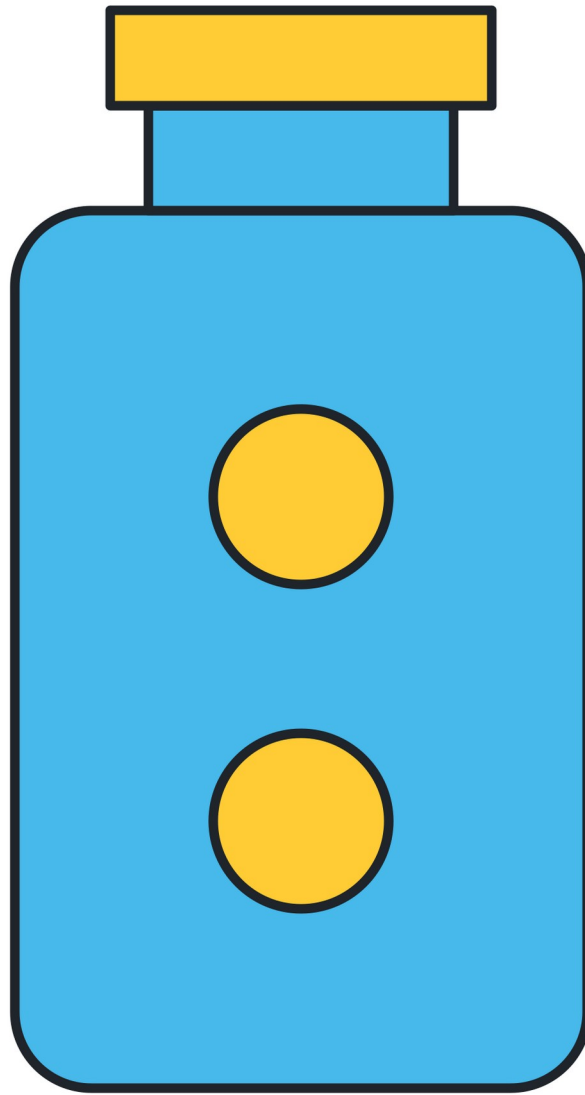


Water Bottle



Make it in MS Paint

1. **Shapes > Rounded rectangle:** Draw the tall bottle body.
2. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Add a short neck, then a wider cap above it.
3. **Shapes > Oval:** Hold Shift while dragging to draw two circles inside.
4. **Fill with color:** Choose blue and click inside the body and neck.
5. **Fill with color:** Choose yellow and click inside the cap and both circles.

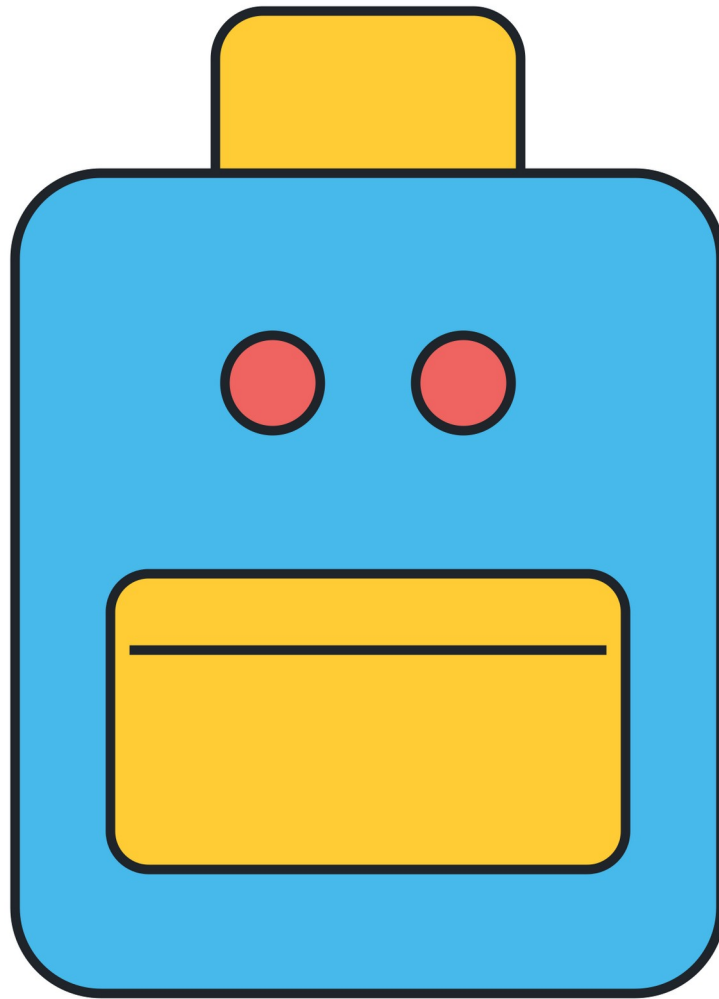

1. **Shapes > Rounded rectangle:** Draw the small yellow handle first.
2. **Shapes > Rounded rectangle:** Draw the large blue bag over the bottom of the handle.
3. **Shapes > Rounded rectangle:** Add a yellow pocket on the front.
4. **Shapes > Line:** Draw a straight line across the pocket for its zip.
5. **Shapes > Oval:** Hold Shift to add two circles. Fill both red.

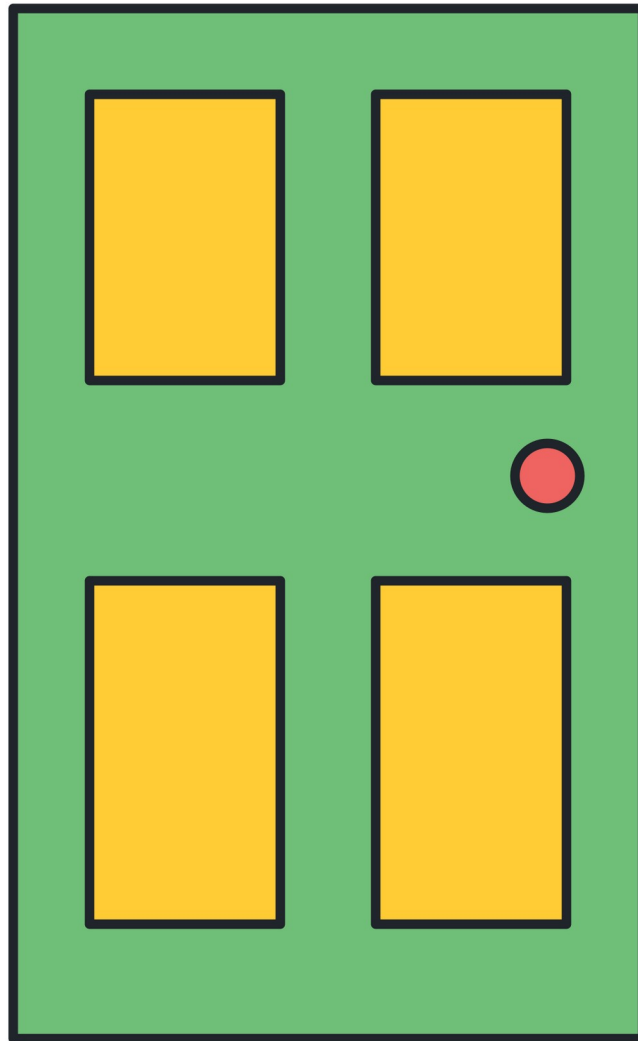

Make it in MS Paint

1. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Draw a tall rectangle for the door.
2. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Add two small rectangles near the top.
3. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Add two more rectangles near the bottom.
4. **Shapes > Oval:** Hold Shift to draw a small round handle on the right.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill the door green, panels yellow and handle red.

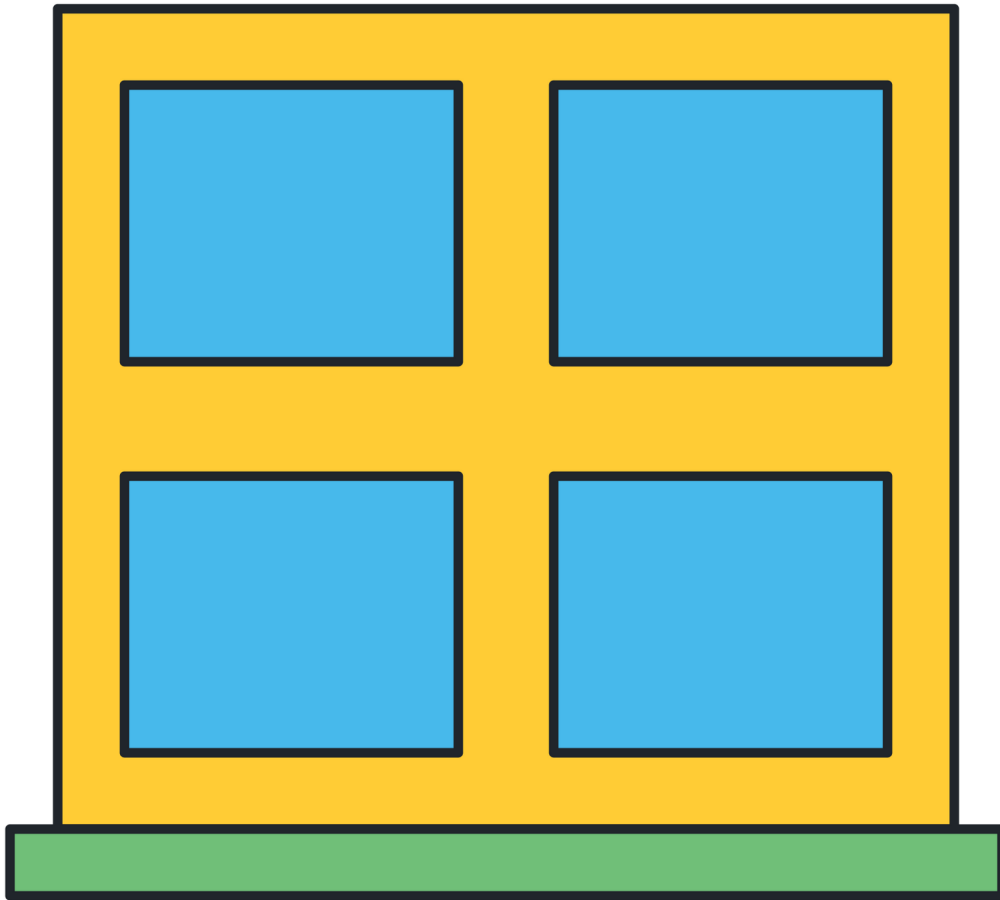

Make it in MS Paint

1. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Draw a large rectangle for the outer frame.
2. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Draw two blue panes across the top.
3. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Draw two blue panes below them. Leave gaps between panes.
4. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Add a long narrow sill below the frame.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill the frame yellow, panes blue and sill green.

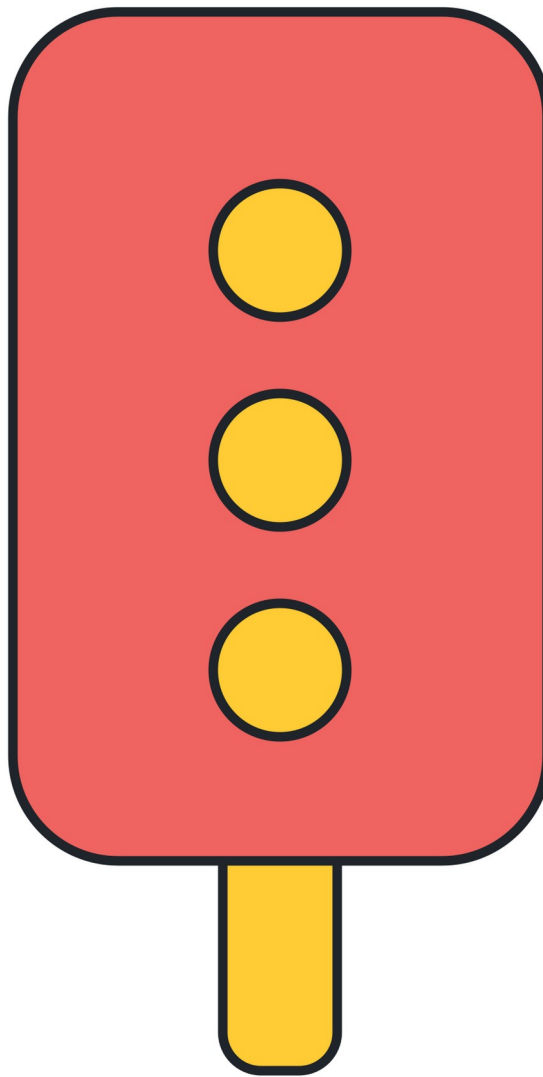

Make it in MS Paint

1. **Shapes > Rounded rectangle:** Draw a narrow stick near the bottom.
2. **Shapes > Rounded rectangle:** Draw the tall ice lolly over the top of the stick.
3. **Shapes > Oval:** Hold Shift to add three circles down the middle.
4. **Fill with color:** Fill the ice lolly red.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill the stick and all three circles yellow.

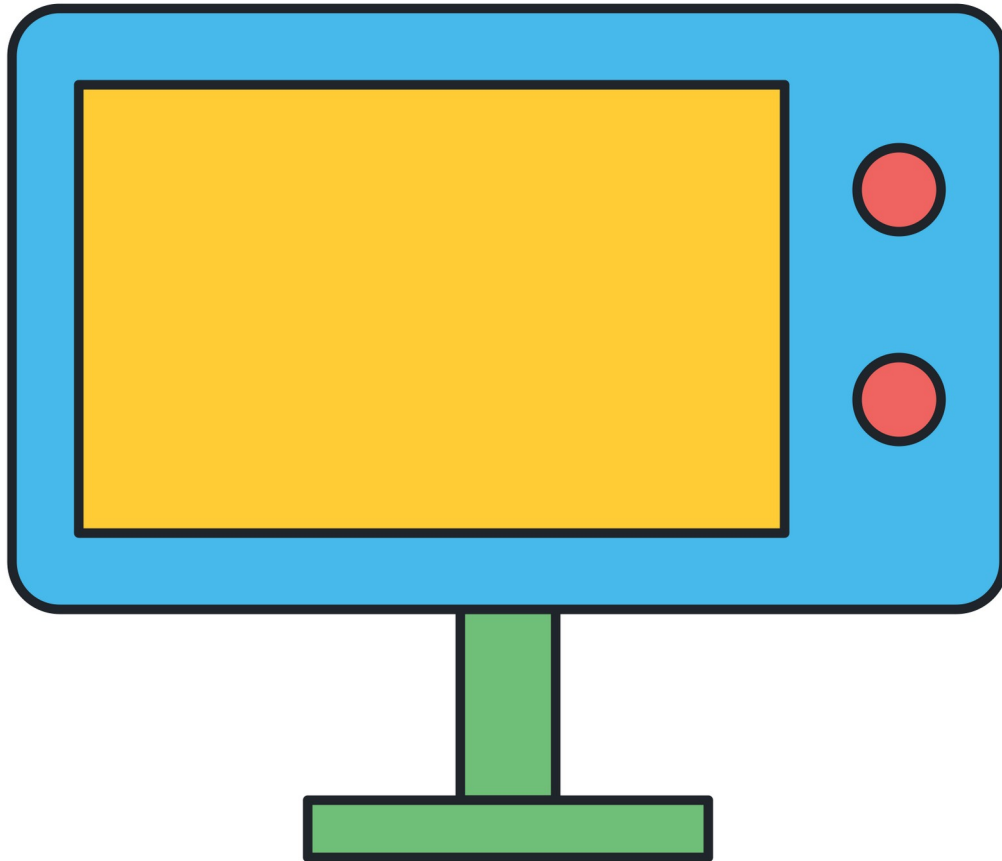

Make it in MS Paint

1. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Draw a short stand and a wide base. Fill them green.
2. **Shapes > Rounded rectangle:** Draw the large television body above the stand.
3. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Add a large screen inside, leaving space on the right.
4. **Shapes > Oval:** Hold Shift to add two round buttons on the right.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill the body blue, screen yellow and buttons red.

Make it in MS Paint

1. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Draw a wide rectangle for the envelope.
2. **Shapes > Line:** Join the top left corner to a point in the middle.
3. **Shapes > Line:** Join that point to the top right corner to close the triangle.
4. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Hold Shift to add a small square near the bottom right.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill the flap blue, envelope yellow and square red.

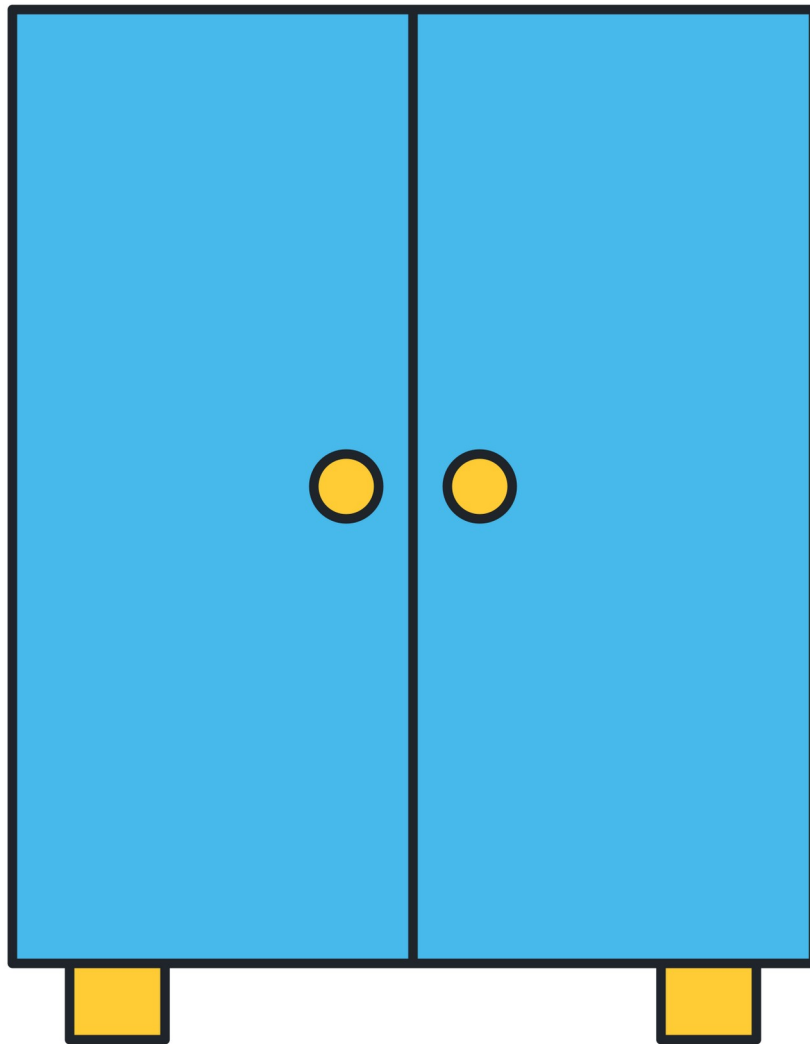

2. **Shapes > Rectangle:** Draw the tall cupboard above the feet.
3. **Shapes > Line:** Draw a vertical line down the centre to make two doors.
4. **Shapes > Oval:** Hold Shift to add two small round handles.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill both doors blue, then the feet and handles yellow.

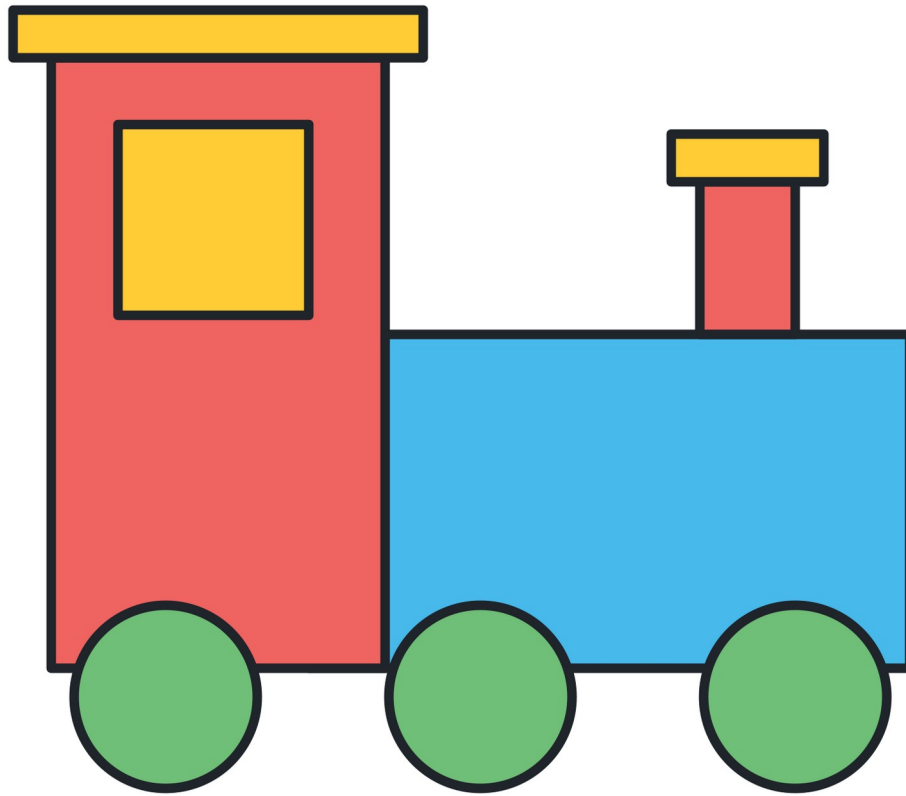

3. **Shapes > Oval:** Hold Shift to draw three equal wheels along the bottom.
4. **Fill with color:** Fill the cab and chimney red, and the engine body blue.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill the window, roof and chimney cap yellow; fill the wheels green.

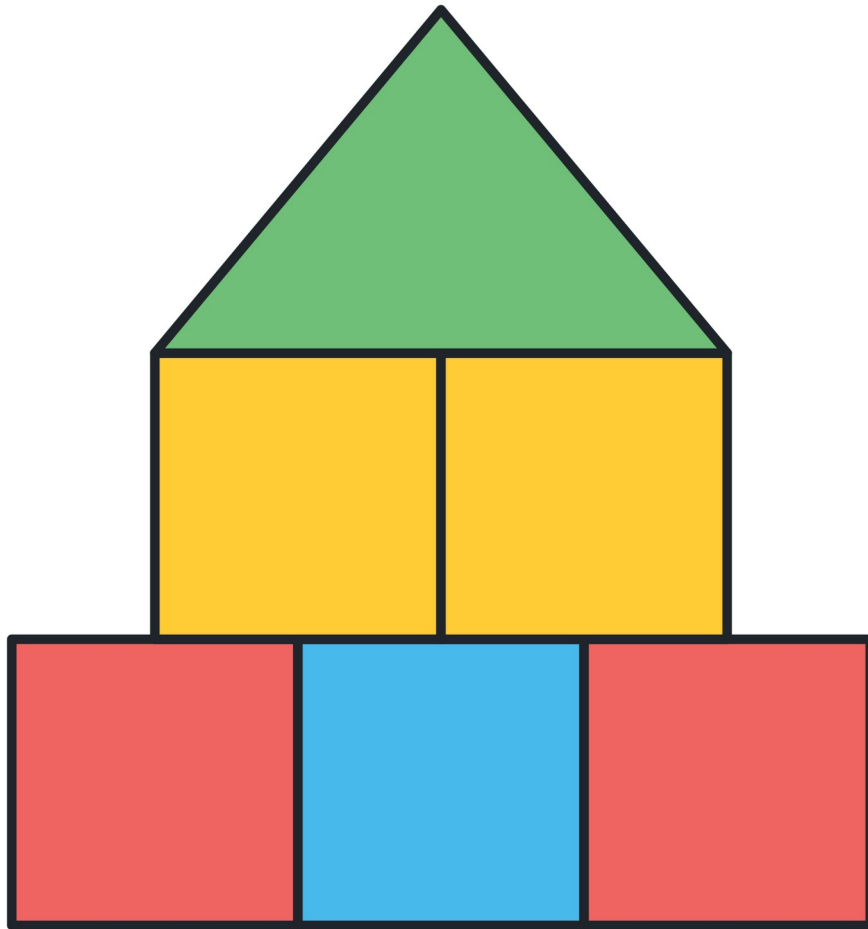

4. **Fill with color:** Fill the bottom squares red, blue and red.
5. **Fill with color:** Fill the two upper squares yellow and the triangle green.
